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WOLGAN VILLA, NEW SOUTH WALES

Rural Retreat

Nestled beneath soaring sandstone cliffs that seem to change colour by the hour, Emirates One&Only Wolgan Valley resort offers the quintessential Australian bush experience, with a heavy dose of luxe alongside the abundant natural wonders. Located within a 7,000-acre conservation and wildlife reserve, guests share the space with free-roaming wallabies and kangaroos, and are woken each morning to the soft sounds of birdsong. Exploring the many nearby ancient trails through pristine bushland, whether on foot, horseback or as part of a 4WD safari, is encouraged to help guests fully immerse in nature and let the city pressures slip away. Of course, there's always the One&Only Spa wellness centre to help you out with that, too. Its six double treatment rooms all have majestic valley views to let in the tranquility of the bush. Accommodation at the resort consists of 40 private villas constructed from local timbers and stone, each with a private pool and spacious verandah. VILLA LA CASSINELLA, LAKE COMO

Lakeside Dream

An online search for this property nets thousands of results that claim it is owned by Sir Richard Branson. The Virgin CEO himself was surprised when on a tour of Lake Como the guide pointed out the luxury property and announced it was his. "George Clooney is reputedly my next-door neighbour," Branson says bemusedly. "My wife Joan is very sad to report that this is untrue." There is still a chance that you could bump into Clooney during your stay at Villa la Cassinella, or Madonna, or Donatella Versace, or any number of celebrities who flock to picturesque Lake Como just an hour north of Milan. Accessible only by boat, the nineteenth century mansion has seven ensuite bedrooms, with a further two in the Terrace House, all decorated with antique Italian furniture and fine art. The villa also boasts a floodlit tennis court, heated infinity pool with reflective 22-carat gold tiles, a cinema, gymnasium, 30,000 square metres of gardens and full staff.

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CASONA DON CARLOS, EMERALD COAST

Seaside Sanctuary

The Emerald Coast, a land of lakes and volcanoes that stretches down the coastline of Nicaragua, is a rare unspoilt patch of paradise. Wanting very much to keep it that way, Don Carlos Pellas, Nicaragua's first billionaire, set out to build the most private beach enclave in the country, even naming it after the Mayan word for 'secret', Mukul. He transformed a beachfront 48-kilometre stretch of land into a 38-room destination resort where artisanal craftsmanship, luxury, and sustainability intertwine to form a utopian compound. Oh and there's also lots of local rum, cigars and art on hand to add some true local flavour. Casona Don Carlos is the Pellas family's private retreat at Mukul and although they are often in residence, the lavish resort is also available to rent. Offering four bedrooms and an incredible 1,850-squaremetre indoor/outdoor living space with soaring seven-metre-high ceilings, the property also boasts a private pool and direct beach access.
